

# XEROX LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP



### **Background**

As a commitment to developing student leadership in the Division, Xerox is sponsoring two (2) annual leadership scholarships for students for six (6) years beginning in the 2013-2014 school year.

It is recognized that leadership is exhibited in many forms in both the school and community. When leadership is demonstrated in these two environments, it can have a remarkable effect on the individual and on others.

## **Funding**

Funding is provided to the Division from Xerox for a six (6) year period. The value of funding is one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) per year for six (6) years.

#### Criteria and Selection

Each high school in the Division has the opportunity to nominate candidates for the Xerox Leadership Scholarship each year. Candidates for the scholarship will:

- 1. Exhibit good citizenship
- 2. Exhibit strong community involvement.
- 3. Exhibit involvement in school or community level leadership.
- 4. Consideration will be given for students involved in school and or community athletic programs.

Students wishing to be considered for this scholarship must apply in writing to the principal by May 31 of their graduating year. The letter or submission must outline their involvement in the school community and provide evidence of the indicators identified above.

The Office of the Superintendent will select the successful candidate(s) from the nominations received from the high schools.

#### **Award**

Two (2) scholarships for five hundred dollars (\$500.00) each are available beginning in the 2013-2014 school year and ending when the funds are expended. These scholarships will be awarded to the successful student.
