District Priority 1: Student Learning

- ✓ Board Chair Rosadiuk welcomed everyone back for the new school year, and shared her excitement that students will be returning to in-school learning, following the Health Best Practices recommended by of the Chief Medical Officer of Health and the Minister of Education.
- ✓ CAMPUS GYPSD provides a range of alternative, innovative and flexible program options for students and families - including distance learning through our **Learn-at-Home** option that offers online and/or print-based resources, hybrid programming (a blend of in-class and online), specialized courses for high school students, and Home Education – with enrichment opportunities for local families.
- ✓ Superintendent Lewis shared the local measures GYPSD staff used to capture student learning in June, and how similar assessments will be used in early September to identify students' strengths and areas for focus. These tools provide teachers with each student's baseline in reading and mathematics, which is used to inform targeted and purposeful instruction.
