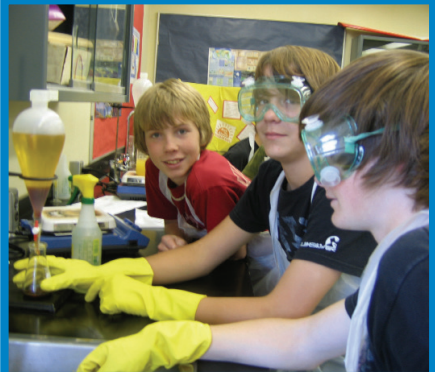

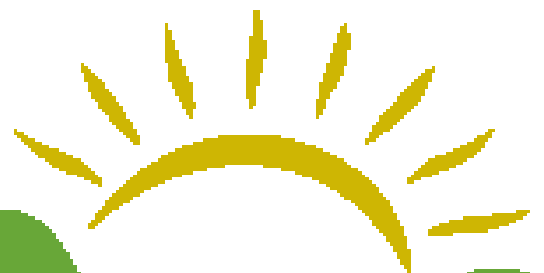

Our High Schools...



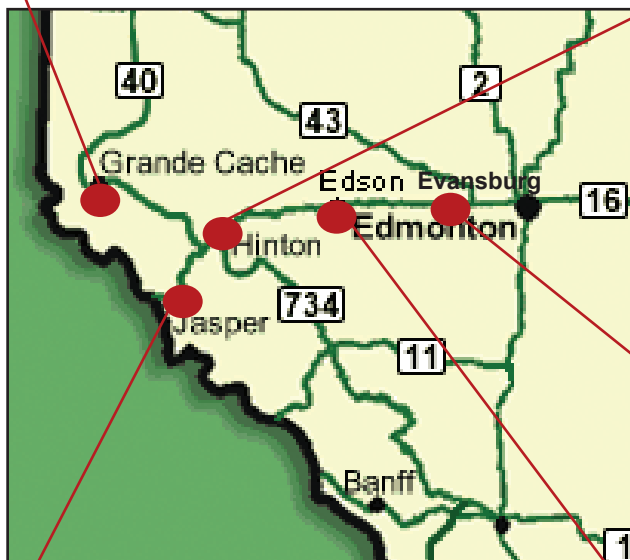

Grande Cache Community High School

Grades 7 to 12, 150 Students

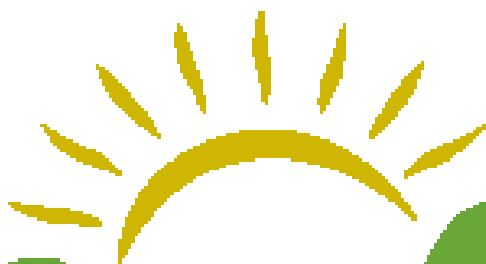
Located in Evansburg, population 1000, only forty minutes from the capital City of Edmonton.

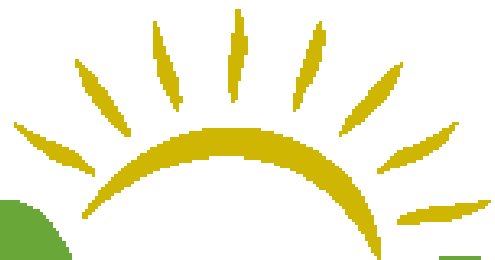
