

ALBERTA HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS

EARN AT LEAST 100 CREDITS BY TAKING REQUIRED COURSES, PLUS OTHER COURSES THAT INTEREST YOU AND HELP YOU ACHIEVE YOUR GOALS.

REQUIRED COURSES:

- English 30-1 or 30-2
- Social Studies 30-1 or 30-2
- Mathematics 20-1 or 20-2 or 20-3
- Science 20 or 24 or Biology 20 or Chemistry 20 or Physics 20*
- Physical Education 10
- Career and Life Management (CALM)

EARN 10 CREDITS, IN ANY COMBINATION, FROM:

- Career and Technology Studies (CTS)
- Fine arts
- Second languages
- Physical Education 20 and/or 30
- Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) courses
- Knowledge and Employability courses; and

EARN 10 CREDITS IN ANY 30-LEVEL COURSE (IN ADDITION TO ENGLISH AND SOCIAL STUDIES), IN ANY COMBINATION, FROM:

- 30-level mathematics, science, fine arts, second languages, CTS, or physical education
 - 30-level locally developed course (learn more about these course options through your high school)
 - 30-level Work Experience
 - 30-level Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP)
 - 30-level Knowledge and Employability courses
 - Advanced level (3000 series) in CTS courses
 - 30-level Green Certificate Specialization courses
 - Special Projects 30
- *The science requirement may also be met with a 10-credit combination of Science 14 and Science 10
