

## **CANADIAN TIRE BURSARY**

## **Background**

Established in 2020 by the dealer/owners of Canadian Tire in Hinton, Alberta to provide post secondary funding to "students with heart" that may otherwise be overlooked.

# **Funding**

This bursary will be available on a year-to-year basis. Each year Canadian Tire in Hinton, Alberta will determine if they will be donating towards the bursary and, if so, the total amount of the bursary.

### **Eligibility Criteria and Selection**

The award will be presented to the students at the annual awards night for Grande Cache Community High School, Harry Collinge High School and Jasper Junior/Senior High School. The principal of the respective school will identify the recipients of the bursaries.

The individuals who are selected shall satisfy the following criteria. The recipient must:

- Be a student registered and completing their senior high school studies at Grande Cache Community High School, Harry Collinge High School or Jasper Junior/Senior High School; and
- 2. Have completed grade 12 at one of the schools noted above; and
- 3. Show that they are a "student with heart" although not necessarily having top grades; and
- 4. Be enrolled in any post secondary institution.

#### **Award**

The Canadian Tire Bursary will consist of a certificate and a cash award. The bursary cash award will depend on the amount donated each year and will be divided equally between each of the following schools: Grande Cache Community High School, Harry Collinge High School and Jasper Junior/Senior High School. The amount awarded to each student will depend on the bursary amount donated and how many students the principal would like to present the award to. The cash award will be paid to the recipient in November.
