

PIDA DISCLOSURE FORM

Under the Public Interest Disclosure (Whistleblower Protection) Act (PIDA), an employee of the Division may make a disclosure of a wrongdoing, which the Division will investigate in accordance with Administrative Procedure 450 - Public Interest Disclosures by Employees. Under PIDA, no person may make reprisals against an employee for making a disclosure, seeking advice about making a disclosure, or taking any other steps under PIDA, so long as the employee is acting in good faith.

Administrative Procedure 450 - Public Interest Disclosures by Employees has the following definition:

- 1.8 “wrongdoing” means:
- a. a contravention of an Act, a regulation made pursuant to an Act, an Act of the Parliament of Canada or a regulation made pursuant to an Act of the Parliament of Canada,
 - b. an act or omission that creates:
 - i. a substantial and specific danger to the life, health or safety of individuals other than a danger that is inherent in the performance of the duties or functions of an employee, or
 - ii. a substantial and specific danger to the environment,
 - c. gross mismanagement of public funds or a public asset, and
 - d. knowingly directing or counselling an individual to commit a wrongdoing mentioned above.
