- Collaborating with EOC for bus use for evacuations



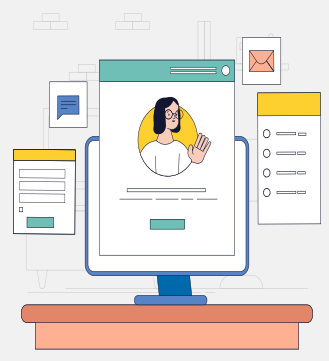

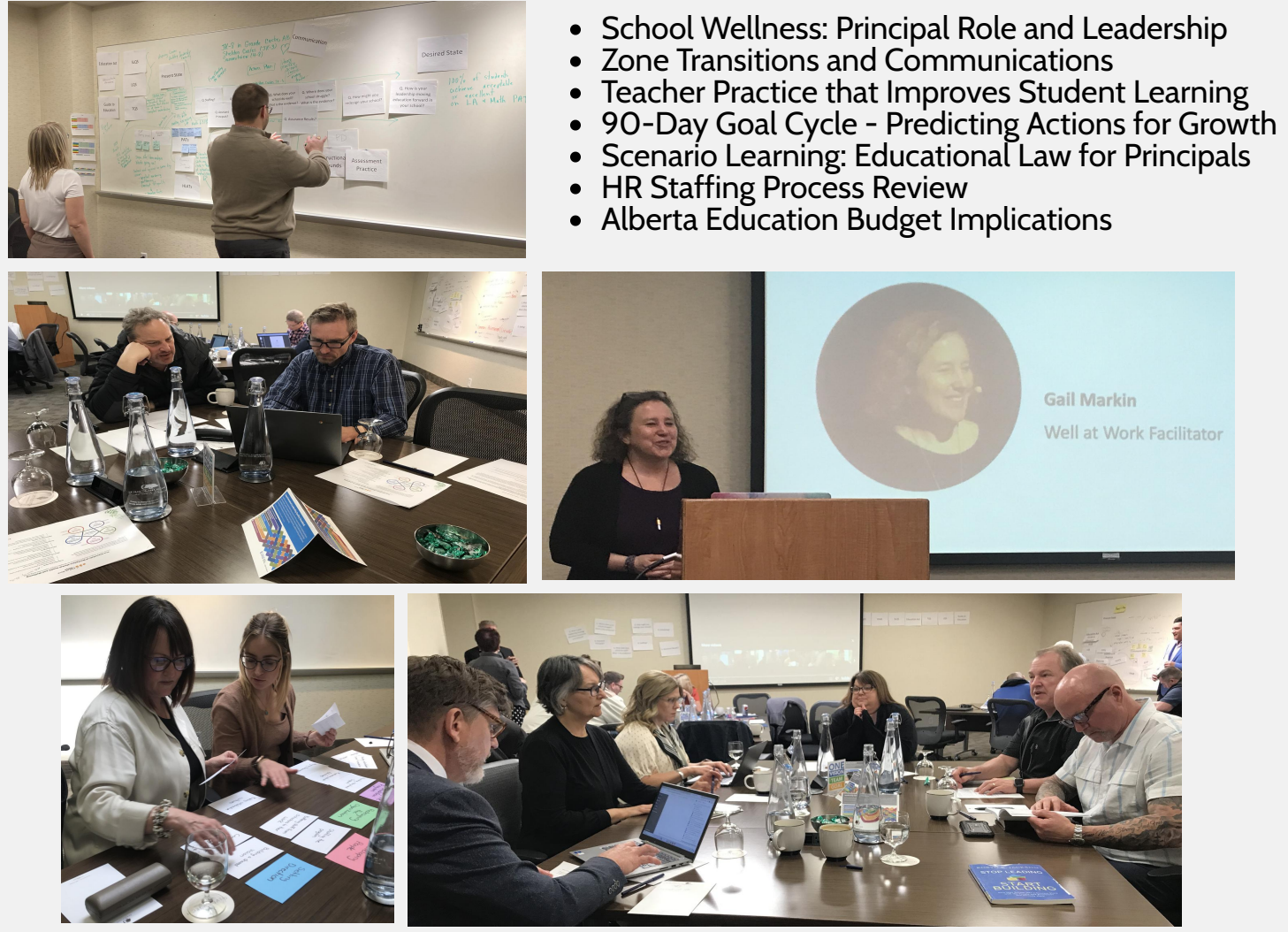

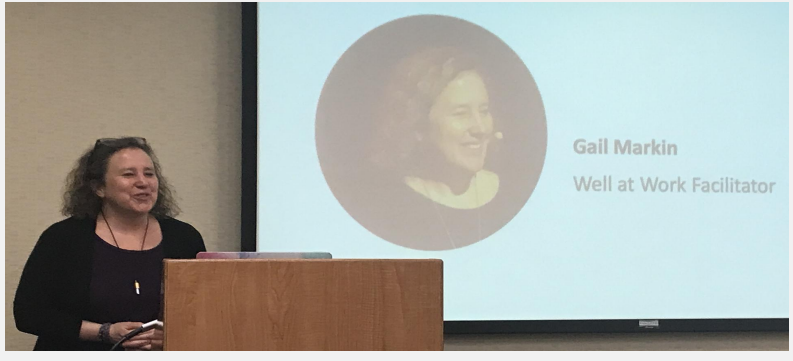
