Worked with principals in August to reflect on the results review process and explore information about student learning to inform a new School Continuous Improvement Plan approach and document to improve access for parents and students.



Led principals and assistant principals through the first DLT meeting of the 2023/24 school year. School leaders reflected on their Vision, Mission, and core values with a lens for improving learning for 100% of their students. Principals will be piloting 90-day Improvement Cycles - implementing a *theory of action* based on research and their professional learning. 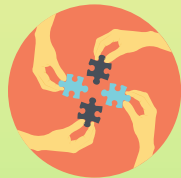
