Re: Charter School Expansion

We are writing to share our concern with your recent announcement of more funds to support the expansion of charter schools; additionally, we respectfully ask you to reconsider the exclusion of local public boards in the charter application process. We want the opportunity to know – and where possible – provide program options wanted by groups in our communities.

Public school boards – while reflecting the goals of local communities - hold the trust of our larger society. A well-funded, inclusive public school system ensures that all children, regardless of their backgrounds, culture, or social-economic status, have access to an excellent education that sets them up for successful participation in our society.

Alberta's international standing as a world leader in public education is founded on its history as a well-funded, research-driven system that welcomes and supports all children, embraces inclusion, celebrates diversity, and strives for community-minded, engaged citizens.
