Re: Increase to Specialized Learning Support Grant

Dear Minister Nicolaides:

On behalf of the Board of Trustees of Grande Yellowhead Public School Division, I am reaching out to advocate for a change in how funding for students requiring specialized learning supports and services is determined and accessed.

As it stands, the Weighted Moving Average and Multi-disciplinary Supports allocation does not adequately provide the necessary funds to support students with complex needs in small, rural jurisdictions. The grant amount that the jurisdiction receives does not expand to meet the many more children being identified, perhaps as a result of the pandemic, as requiring specialized supports and services.

Our Board wishes to share our appreciation for the addition of the Low Incidence Supports and Services grant. However, the time and staff required to complete the granting application process is a challenge for small jurisdictions.

The allocation formula, the unpredictability of funds, combined with the great distances between our communities, makes it very difficult to arrange for and provide timely assessments, build a responsive system, monitor program success, meet with parents, arrange for specialists, and build capacity across staff.

As you know, we are passionate about our role to ensure excellent public education in rural Alberta. Small boards with small enrolments do not have the economy of scale needed to ensure optimal learning environments in inclusive classrooms. We do not want our rural special needs children being left behind because of where they live.
