Dear Jasper Parents,

With the start of the school year just around the corner, we know that many of you have questions about the status of schools in Jasper and where your children will be attending school to start the new school year. We are committed to keeping you informed and to making sure plans are in place to maintain educational continuity and a healthy back-to-school routine for you and your children during these difficult times. The health, well-being and safety of students are our highest priority and will inform all decisions as we work to welcome students back to school.

At this time, we know that schools in Jasper will not be ready to open at the start of the school year, and we are working to determine a timeline by which it will be safe and possible for students, teachers and support staff to return to school. The key considerations include the safety of the school buildings themselves, accommodation for teachers and staff, and the overall readiness of the school facilities. We are working with the Alberta government to expedite resources such as cleanup contractors and accommodations for teachers and support staff. We commit to providing more details on when schools will reopen as they become available.

To maintain educational continuity and important back-to-school routines for families and students, we are working closely with the Alberta government and partner school authorities to provide several options for Jasper students to attend school to start the year.

In the Grande Yellowhead Public School Division, we are preparing to accommodate students in school facilities in Hinton and Edson. We are also working to provide online learning options as a temporary measure to start the year. To register your children to attend school in Edson or Hinton, please contact us at registration@gypsd.ca.

If Hinton or Edson are not options for you, you can register your children to attend school in any Alberta community by contacting the local school authority (you can find a full list of authorities (here). For those of you staying in reception centres in Edmonton, Calgary and Grande Prairie, you are welcome to register your children to attend schools in those communities by contacting the local school authorities listed below. They will work with you to find a school for your children.
