

# 2025 Calendar Survey Results



## First Instructional Day

**58%** of families, Grade 10-12 students, and staff support a flexible first instructional day for students for those years where Labour Day falls late. *eg. Sept. 1 instead of Sept. 8 for 2026.* 

#### **Christmas Break**


■ 62% of families, Grade 10-12 students and staff prefer Christmas Break commencing on the weekend before Christmas Day and 77% prefer a flexible Christmas Break with a balance of days off before and after December 25th.


## **Spring and Fall Breaks**

- **60%** of families, Grade 10-12 students and staff support an earlier first instructional day for students if it allowed for a longer Fall Break.
- **75%** of families, Grade 10-12 students and staff support the current policy that sets when Spring Break begins.
- **63%** of families, Grade 10-12 students and staff would like to see Spring Break linked to Easter if it provides for a longer holiday.
- **86%** of families, Grade 10-12 students and staff support the Board to see if Easter Monday can become a Board holiday for all staff if feasible.
- **65%** of families, Grade 10-12 students and staff **do not** support the Board eliminating the Fall Break and extending the Spring Break to two weeks.

## National Truth & Reconciliation Day

**76%** of families, Grade 10-12 students, and staff support the Board to see if The National Day for Truth and Reconciliation can become a Board holiday for all staff if feasible.
